CM/ECF Trustee/US Trustee Agreement

By registering for a live account on the Court's CM/ECF system with **TRUSTEE/US TRUSTEE FILING PRIVILEGES**, I acknowledge that I have read, understand and agree to adhere to the following terms and conditions with respect to my electronic filing privileges:

1. I agree to adhere to all of the rules, orders, guidelines, requirements, instructions and local forms (including subsequent amendments) or any other directives issued by the Clerk of the Bankruptcy Court for the Central District of California in conjunction with use of this Court's EM/ECF system.
2. I must maintain a valid primary e-mail address to receive Notices of Electronic Filing. I must immediately notify the ECF help desk via e-mail (ECF_support@cacb.uscourts.gov) of any change in my primary e-mail address or mailing address. Registered users who have also registered with BNC for noticing purposes must also notify the BNC of changes in service address information.
3. Pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 9011, use of my login and password constitutes my signature on an electronically filed document for all purposes, including those under Rule 9011 and 28 U.S.C. §1746, and shall have the same force and effect as if I had affixed my signature on a paper copy of the document being filed. I must type or print my name on any document filed by me either above or below the signature line.
4. The Trustee/US Trustee login and password assigned to me is to be used only for those cases in which I am acting in the capacity of the Trustee or US Trustee in that specific case. When the Court offers electronic filing via CM/ECF to attorneys, I understand that I must register separately as an attorney user for all other cases in which I intent to file documents with this Court.
